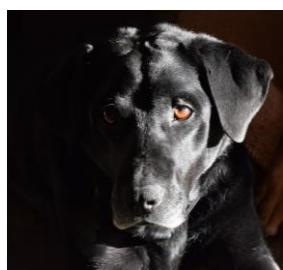


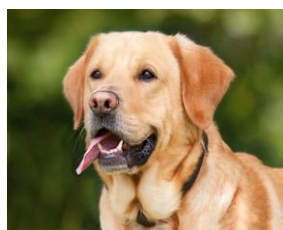
Take part in research into idiopathic epilepsy and paroxysmal dyskinesia in Labrador Retrievers

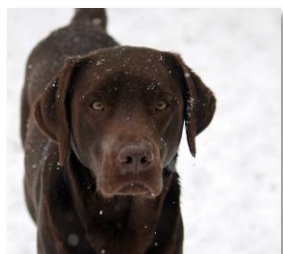
